

The difference between interprofessional collaboration and interdisciplinary collaboration

Interprofessional collaboration

- between experts of different professional groups who are active in a school
- e. g. teachers, speech therapists, social workers, teaching and learning assistants, ...
- in the I CO-COPE context students and their families are also meant here

Interdisciplinary collaboration

- between experts with the same profession (teachers) but from different fields, disciplines or classes
- e. g. different class teachers or subject teachers, special needs teachers and mainstream teachers, ...
